Notice of Race

Rules: The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012 and prescriptions of US Sailing, applicable class rules, this notice and the Sailing Instructions. The Regatta is classified as Category A. Measurement certificates will not be required.

Entry: This Regatta is open to any Portsmouth Rated Boat. Any One Design fleet bringing 5 or more boats will have their own start and be scored separately. Please contact, johnocon@mindspring.com, if you plan to bring an OD fleet.

Entrants must complete registration with Port Oliver Yacht Club (POYC), the organizing authority, to be eligible to compete. Any fleet of less than 5 boats will compete in an Open Portsmouth fleet. Classes will be determined by the race committee. Probable classes are Cruiser, Dinghy, and Multihull.

Includes: Skipper's Dinner on Saturday.

Schedule of Events: Saturday, May 30, 2009;

Skippers meeting ~ 09:30 am (ish). Racing

starts at ~10:30 am. Sunday racing usually starts around 10:am

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available at registration before the skippers meeting. Possible courses: Windward/Leeward, Olympic, modified Olympic, or Distance as described in the Sailing Instructions. General instructions for POYC Regattas can be found on the forms page of the POYC website (<http://www.ussailing.net/poyc/>).

Scoring: The low-point scoring system described in Appendix A of the RRS will apply, except that there will be no throw outs. Two races will constitute a regatta. Portsmouth handicap (DPN) time on time scoring will be employed for the races. **Notes:** Race committee will communicate to competitors via the usual visual and sound signals.

Trophies: Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers of each class in the fleet.

Launching and Facilities

POYC has a concrete launching ramp (with dock) for your convenience.

There are hot showers available at POYC. Racers are welcome to camp on the grounds.
